### Dues Due

Section 2: Any other Democrat who physically resides in the 11<sup>th</sup> District is eligible for membership and may become a voting member four weeks after payment of annual dues. Proof of residency may be required. Any Democrat who does not reside in the District may become a non-voting affiliate after payment of annual dues.

Section 3: Annual Dues / Subscriptions are:

a) Household Membership (2 individuals at same address)	\$27.00
b) Individual Membership (1 individual)	\$15.00
c) Student or Senior (1 individual)	\$10.00
d) Low-Income, Permanently Disabled (1 individual)	\$ 6.00
e) Supporter Only, no voting rights (per address)	\$10.00
f) Household Monthly Membership (2 individuals at the same address)	\$5.00 / month

g) Dues are payable in February of each year. A member joining after February may prorate their dues payment for the remaining quarters of the year. Memberships shall be valid through January of the following year. If a member decides to pay their dues monthly, a \$5 / month minimum payment is required through our online payment provider.
